Your work will be enriched by maintaining sketchbooks, workbooks, and journals, where you'll document research, ideas, and reflections on broader theoretical and contextual themes. Whether you're building a portfolio or seeking personal growth, this course is your opportunity to immerse yourself in the world of art.

Standard A Level entry requirements: 5 x GCSE grade 5's or above (must include Maths and English Language). However, certain subjects may have additional entry criteria, which can be found below:

Additional Entry Requirements:

A Level Art will require grade 5 in GCSE Art or a portfolio.

## What You Will Learn

---

To enrich your learning, the course includes theoretical and contextual studies supported by a variety of external visits and guest speakers. You will participate in two immersive residential trips: a 3-day London visit in the first year and a 5-day European trip in the second year, offering unique exposure to art and culture beyond the classroom.

## Assessment

---

There will be a combination of practical/written work and externally examined coursework.

Successful students are guaranteed a place on the Foundation Diploma in Art & Design at Trafford College. Alternatively, students can apply directly for degree level programmes in a related subject.

## Career Options
