Course Overview

A short introductory course designed to raise awareness of AI in everyday life. Through discussion and booklet activities, learners will explore what AI is, where it appears, and how it can be used thoughtfully as a support tool rather than a replacement for thinking.

Course Requirements

No formal entry requirements. Students should have an interest in the topic and be willing to take part in discussion and booklet-based activities. No prior knowledge is needed.

What You Will Learn

Students will explore what AI is, where it appears in everyday life, the benefits and limitations of AI, the difference between using AI as a tool or a crutch, and how to think critically about AI-generated information.

Assessment

There is no formal assessment. Learning will be checked through discussion, questioning, booklet activities, scenario tasks and end-of-session reflection.

Progression

Students may progress onto other digital, employability, personal development or community learning courses.
