Course Overview

You will be provided with online resources to support your studies alongside your face to face classroom sessions.

Course Requirements

You must be aged 19+. You are expected to have achieved GCSE Maths and English at a grade C or above and a merit at level 2 accounting. You will be asked to complete an initial assessment to ensure your numeracy and literacy skills are sufficient to do well on the course. You will be expecting to be working towards a minimum of a level 2 for both Maths and English to commence the programme.

You must have access to a computer/laptop at home supported by Wi Fi. This is to enable access to all online materials throughout the programme via Microsoft Teams.

On this Level 3 course, students will become proficient in a number financial process of a greater complexity than the previous levels, such as final accounts for sole traders and partnerships, Professional ethics and reports and returns.
