Course Overview

The course offers an entry-level overview of the industry, striking a balance between practical skill development and theoretical knowledge. Our Level 1 Professional program offers two tracks: Hair and Make-up, or Beauty and Nails.

Practical sessions will encompass a variety of demonstrations, workshops, discussions, and research activities, enabling you to express your ideas through hands-on work and a portfolio of evidence. Theoretical classes will focus on expanding your understanding through discussions and question-and-answer sessions, all in preparation for written exams.

A minimum of 36 hours work experience which is integral to the course and is assessed as part of the practical element.
