This is a 'First Steps' programme which gives learners a taste of different vocational sectors such as construction crafts, gas and plumbing, multi-skills, motor vehicle. On successful completion of the course, learners can progress to a Level 1 qualification in their chosen sector.

Course Requirements

4 GCSE's at Grade 1 or above including English and maths

What You Will Learn

The qualification provides a pathway into a range of sectors giving learners the opportunity to develop knowledge, skills and behaviours associated with different job roles before deciding which career progression they wish to choose.

Learners will study GCSE maths and English alongside their qualification.
