## **Course Overview**

This course is for adult students and is intended for all of those who are interested in cutting men's hair and continuing their journey in the barbering industry.

Students will need to wear professional clothing and be expected to bring their own equipment or purchase a basic kit with the tools needed to complete the course. A gent's block head is used to support and develop cutting skills and will need to be purchased prior to the course.

## **Course Requirements**

There are no course specific qualifications required to join this course, however, there is an expectation candidates have dexterity skills and a good standard of English. A practical activity and a short written test will be given at interview to assess suitability.

The course will provide learners with an opportunity to develop and learn the skills needed to demonstrate basic cuts to industry standard.
