Career Options

Salon Assistant: Assisting senior stylists and beauticians with various tasks such as shampooing, conditioning, cleaning, and maintaining the salon's cleanliness.

Retail Sales Assistant: Working in beauty supply stores or department store beauty sections, providing assistance to customers, recommending products, and processing sales transactions.

Spa Attendant: Assisting clients in a spa environment, ensuring their comfort, providing towels and robes, and maintaining the cleanliness of spa facilities.

Trainee Beautician or Hair Stylist: Beginning a formal apprenticeship or on-the-job training program to further develop skills in either hair styling or beauty treatments.

Make-up Counter Assistant: Working at cosmetic counters in department stores, providing make-up demonstrations, assisting customers in selecting products, and offering beauty advice.

Freelance Assistant: Supporting independent hair stylists or beauticians with tasks such as setting up equipment, preparing materials, and assisting during appointments.

Junior Receptionist: Working at the front desk of a salon or spa, handling appointment bookings, managing client inquiries, and maintaining client records.

While these roles are typically entry-level positions, individuals with a Level 1 Diploma in Hair and Beauty Skills can use these opportunities to gain valuable experience and skills that can pave the way for advancement within the industry.

Additionally, further education and training, such as pursuing higher-level qualifications or specialised certifications, can open up more advanced career pathways in areas such as hairdressing, beauty therapy, salon management, or even entrepreneurship in the beauty industry.
