Experience, explore and enhance your creative textiles skills. This is a relaxed, informative and fun course for anyone that that wants to develop their practical textiles knowledge. You will expand your skills in hand and machine embroidery, including working with dissolvable fabric and machinery such as domestic sewing machines, over lockers and wax pots. You will be introduced to experimental knitting and weaving, needle felting and resist dyeing techniques such as batik and shibori. This course will provide you with the opportunity to explore your textile awareness, develop your knowledge, build your technical ability and experiment with all things fabric and thread.

Course Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this course however an interest in art, design and textiles is preferred.
