Course Overview

You will be asked to complete an initial assessment to ensure literacy skills are sufficient to do well on the course. You should have a level 2 for both Maths and English to commence the programme or be working at this level.

What You Will Learn

The units in these qualifications cover a wide range of skills, knowledge and understanding. These include units that focus on communication, working with people, and providing direction via effective mentoring and support.

Assessment

Assessment will be through a range of methods including written reports and carrying out interviews.
